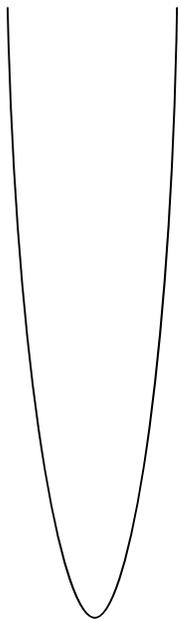
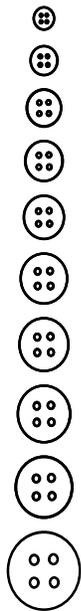


# BUTTON UP THE CHRISTMAS TREE!

First things first! Let's get our supplies ready:



Wire bent in an even "U" shape



10 plastic buttons, arranged largest to smallest



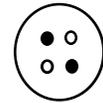
One star button



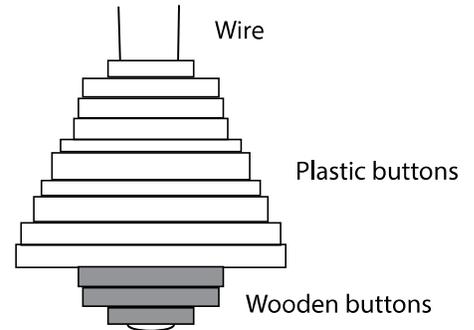
3 wooden buttons, arranged smallest to largest



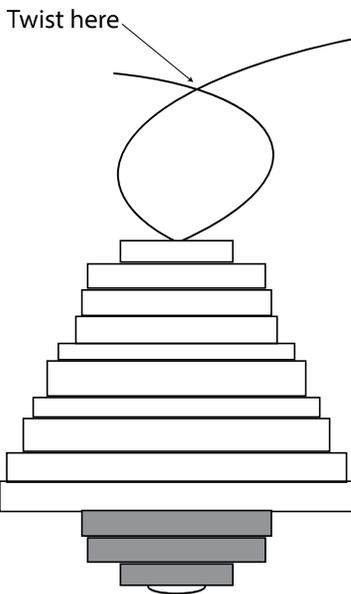
First, thread your 3 wooden buttons onto the wire, starting with the smallest button. Make sure that you thread the buttons using two holes that are diagonal to each other:



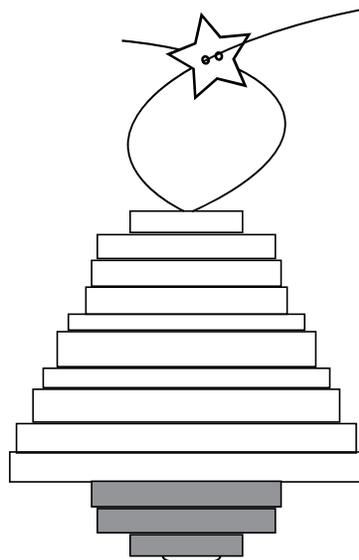
Next, do the same with your 10 plastic buttons - but this time, thread them on from largest to smallest (in the shape of a Christmas tree!)



Tip: if the ends of your wire get frayed, you can snip a tiny bit off the end with scissors to get a fresh point!

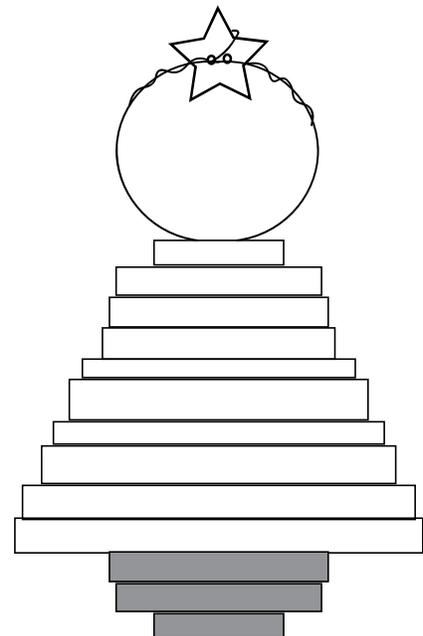


Next, cross and twist the wire so that it forms a circle above the tree.



Thread your star button onto only one of the wires, then wrap that wire down along one side of the circle, securing the star in place.

Lastly, wrap the other end of the wire around the opposite side of the circle, then arrange your star over the tree by bending the wire until the star is centered and facing forward.



Awesome job!  
You have finished your Christmas tree and it's ready to be hung somewhere special.
