## Poinsettia Ornament

## **SUPPLIES:**


String (2)

Coffee filter (2)
Red acrylic paint
Foam brush
Glue
Small clothespins (4-5)
Toilet paper tubes (not included)
Scissors (not included)

**STEP 1:** Wet your foam brush with water and spread over the filters until they are completely wet.

Dip the brush in a little paint and spread over the filters until completely covered.

Some areas may have more paint than others and that's okay! Set them aside to dry.



Cut them before painting the inside. Use your foam brush to paint the tube inside and out, then set aside to dry.

Once the tubes are dry, press flat and cut them into slices. You should get about 8 slices per tube. The more tubes, the more ornaments you can make!

STEP 3: Trace the edge of the sliced tubes with glue and place it on the coffee filter to dry. Make sure to leave one petal with one end open for your string!

Once the petals dry, trim away the extra paper.

Glue six petals together, just like the picture shows using your mini clothespins to hold them until they dry.

Run one piece of string through the outer tip of one of the petals for hanging. Now you have an ornament to hang! Merry Christmas from D+B!!!
